





"2. Did you negotiate your financial product distribution contract with the firm, general agent, insurance company?"



"3. Today, are you aware of your obligations in the distribution contract(s) you have signed?"




"4. Do you consider your current contracts to be free of conflicts of interest with the company?"



"5. In your opinion, what is your level of responsibility for a cybersecurity attack or data loss involving your customers' confidential information stipulated in your distribution contracts?"





"7. Would you be interested in having APCSF work to create a single model distribution contract for all of its members to standardize and delineate the responsibilities of each party?"




"9. On a scale of 1 to 5 (5 being very important), how important to you are the prescriptive clauses in the distribution contract:

a. Conflicts of interest with the company






